<p>The Forest City Riders MC is incorporated by the State of Illinois as a non-profit organization. Its purpose is to provide recreational enjoyment for its members and to promote good will toward motorcycling. Membership implies that you are willing to share the work and responsibilities of the club as well as the enjoyment of its activities. With acceptance of this application I understand that a probationary period (if applicable) of such time as is prescribed by the By-laws of this organization must be duly served before permanent status on the Club Roster is awarded. During my probationary period (if applicable), I shall endeavor to promote the sport of motorcycling by conduct which can be looked upon with favor. I also understand that the Forest City Riders MC cannot assume responsibility for any aspect of my safety and that I understand that riding on the club grounds or participating in a club event, I do so voluntarily on my own assessment of my own ability, the course and all the facilities and conditions, assuming "ALL" risk; and I release and hold the Forest City Riders M/C harmless for any injury or loss to my person or property which may result there from. I understand that this means that I agree not to sue the Forest City Riders for any injury resulting to myself or my property at any such event.</p>

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Due Structure



Dues are for calendar year - January to January - and are to be paid by March 1st of each year

When the club does not have a club grounds the following due structure will be followed:

Dues are \$25.00 and there is a one time initiation fee is \$50.00

Dues Structure for Officers, Chairpersons, and long time members is as follows:

- 1) Club officers dues are \$0.00
- 2) Event chairperson dues are \$10.00
- 3) Club members with 15 consecutive plus years of service, dues are \$10.00
- 4) Club members with 25 consecutive plus years of service, dues are \$0.00

When the club has a club grounds the following due structure will be followed:

Dues initially start at \$200.00 and there is a one time initiation fee is \$50.00

Dues may be reduced to a minimum of \$100.00 for the following year by the following participation:

- 1) Attendance at club meetings will reduce dues by \$5.00 for each meeting attended.
- 2) Working prior to, at the event, or after the event will reduce dues by \$15.00 for each participation up to \$30.00 maximum. Events are considered the Enduro, Dual Sport, Hare Scramble, etc.
- 3) Representing the club at the AMA District 17 Sanction meeting will reduce the dues by \$15.00
- 4) Attendance at the Club Picnic and Winter Banquet will reduce the dues by \$15.00 for each event.
- 5) Working Club ground work days will reduce dues by \$10.00 for each work day worked

Working club events is not mandatory, but encouraged. If no events are worked dues stay at \$200.00

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- 1) Club officers dues are \$25.00
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Club Ground Guidelines



Please review the following guidelines before heading out to have fun at the club grounds. These guidelines are in place to insure that all club members can enjoy the club grounds for years to come.

- * Immediate family is welcome to enjoy the club grounds (husband, wife, children)
- * One guest is allowed per club family membership
- * Appropriate safety equipment is required by all riders
- * Do not ride in the planted area
- * Stay within the property boundaries, please no "exploring"
- * Do not ride in the adjacent fields
- * Take your trash with you
- * No Three or Four wheelers. (unless needed for maintenance)
- * Camping is permitted
- * Fire permitted in the existing fire pit, extinguish when leaving
- * Lock the gates when leaving in a manner that either lock will open the gate
- * No unusually loud mufflers, all motorcycles should be under 96db
- * A spark arrestor is recommended, especially in dry summer months
- * It is recommended to wrap 4-Stroke headers, especially in dry summer months
- * Minors (<18 years) are to ride under the following supervision: parent, guardian or adult club member
- * Stay on existing trails, DO NOT tear up grass areas on either side of the driveway
- * No racing up and down the driveway, drive slowly, use common sense
- * Fishing in the pond is permitted, but catch and release is encouraged
- * Swimming in the pond is not permitted, there are snapping turtles
- * Recommended quiet time is from 10pm to 9am
- * If inclement weather please refrain from riding and tearing up the trails
- * Follow common sense, treat this property with respect, your riding here depends on it
